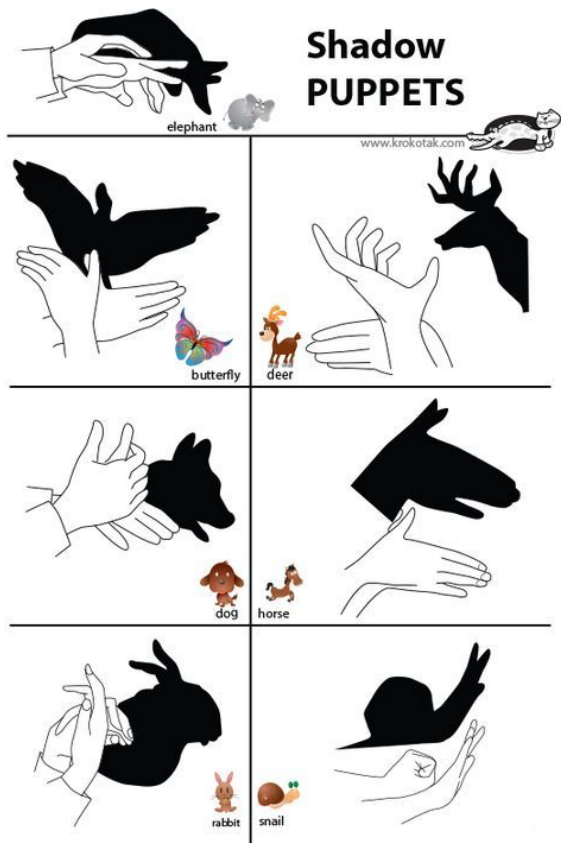


Make Shadow Puppets



Make Ghost Mud

You'll need three ingredients:

- Toilet paper
- A bar of ivory soap
- A cup of very warm water

How to make it:

1. Unroll at least 1/3 of the toilet paper roll
2. Put the toilet paper in a large bowl or basin
3. Grate the bar of soap into another bowl or basin
4. Add the cup of very warm water
5. Mix the soap and water until it gets mushy
6. Add the mushy soap water to the toilet paper
7. Mush and knead the mixture for several minutes

Make Goop

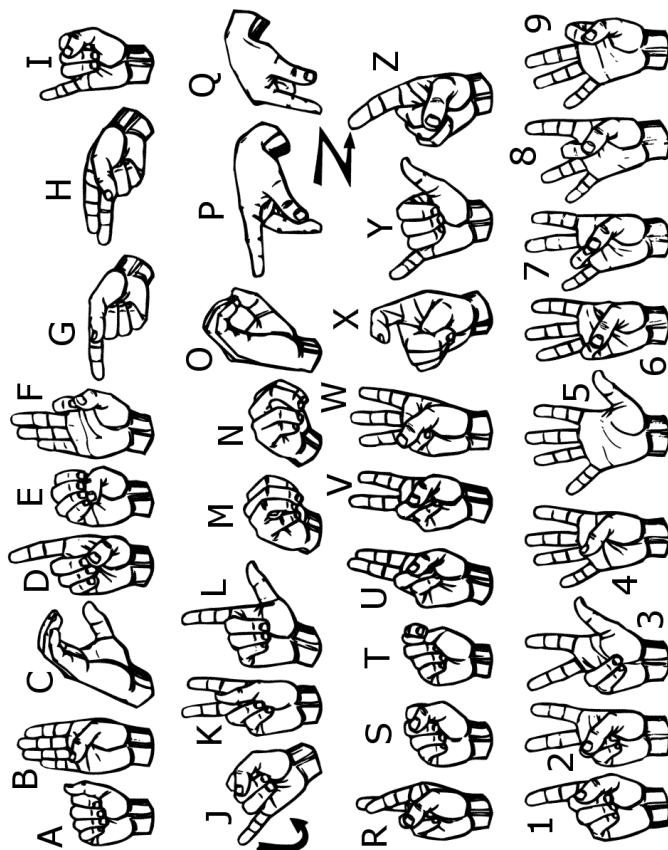
You'll need two ingredients:

- Cornstarch
- Water

How to make goop:

1. Put cornstarch in a bowl
2. Add water for a ratio of 2:1 (two parts cornstarch to one part water) to the bowl
3. You may add food colouring or glitter to your liking

Here is some guidance for some of your Summer Bucket List Challenges. You don't need a screen to be creative!

Make Play Dough

You'll need 4 ingredients:

- 1 cup of flour
- 1/4 cup of salt
- 1/2 cup of water
- 3-5 drops of food colouring

How to make play dough:

1. Mix the flour and salt
2. Mix the water and food colouring
3. Slowly pour the water mixture into the flour mixture while stirring
4. Knead until the flour is completely absorbed

Troubleshooting:

- If the dough is too sticky, add more flour
