#### Fire Service

- The Fire Service responded to a total of seven incidents, including three medical emergencies, three remote alarms, and one public service.
- The yearly cleaning and hydrostatic testing of all bunker gear has been carried out successfully.
- FireFixx completed the annual ladder testing on November 13th and 14th.
- The Amkus Extrication equipment underwent its annual inspection and servicing on November 15th.

### Fire Services

#### Regional Training Center

- 12 students are confirmed for the NFPA 1072 HazMat Awareness and Operation training offered to all Fire Services in the United County of Leeds & Grenville. The course is scheduled from December 1st to December 17th.
- Z Endorsement Course is scheduled for November 18-19 at the Regional Training Center. Seven students are enrolled, and an additional four students are completing their driver's tests.

#### Fire Prevention

- The OPP requested assistance from Fire Services, Building, and By-law for a wellness check.
- A winner was announced for the final smoke alarm contest, and they were driven to school in a fire truck. Congratulations to the winner and thanks to everyone who participated. Approximately 25 individuals from both Sweets Corners and T.I.E.S. schools took part.
- A landlord who failed to comply with regulations regarding smoke and carbon monoxide alarms was fined nine times by the province. Unfortunately, in 2022, 133 Ontario residents died due to fire-related incidents. Most of these were caused by non-functional or missing smoke alarms. This serves as a reminder to everyone to check their alarms regularly, including expiry dates and battery replacements twice a year. Early detection is crucial for survival.

### Operations & Infrastructure

#### Administration

- 13 new service requests were received, and 12 were resolved. In total, 17 work orders were completed.

#### Roads

The Seabrooke Road underwent ditching and culvert installation.
