Fire Services

- Fire services responded to 5 incidents: 1 CO alarm, 1 motor vehicle accident, 1 hydro line arcing, 1 structure fire, and an investigation.
- Dry hydrant repair and related issues have been addressed on the parkway.
- Stations 1 and 3 received auto extrication training at Campbell's Towing in Brockville. The Fire Service thanks Campbell's Towing for their continued support.
- Chief Fire Officers of Leeds and Grenville group met remotely to discuss the Fire Service County Wide Food Drive for 2024.
- Training was conducted at Station 4 for the purpose of teaching how to perform annual Air Pack mask testing.
- On January 29th, six children attended the Firefighters in Training group. They were led through the process of putting on firefighting gear and equipment, and then performed several fun firefighting tasks while in gear.

Regional Training Center

- NFPA 1041 Fire Instructor training was completed over the past weekend.

Fire Prevention
