## **Fire Services**

Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 5 incidents. 1 medical, 1 fire (grass), 1 burn complaint, 1 motor vehicle accident and 1 public service.
- Inventory of radios was completed for the Chief Officer of Leeds and Grenville, as county departments are planning future upgrades. This initiative began ten years ago with the transition to digital technology.

### Regional Training Center

- The final fireground training for the Firefighter 1 Recruit class is taking place this weekend, April 6-7.
- Off-site delivery of the NFPA 1001 Firefighter II begins in Augusta on April 5.

#### Fire Prevention

- On Saturday, March 30, a public education event was held at Swiftwind Equestrian Center. Several trucks and firefighters were present, along with Sparky who supervised an Easter egg hunt. Approximately 50 children, as well as adults, attended.
- School visit held at Thousand Islands Elementary on Wednesday, April 3rd. Five firefighters delivered public education regarding electrical safety and solar eclipse safety to nine classes.
- A re-inspection at a commercial occupancy was completed.
- A meeting with the Building, Planning and Bylaw department was held as a follow up at some commercial occupancies.
