Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 9 incidents. 2 public service, 1 mutual aid assistance to Front of Yonge for a grass fire, 1 fire (grass), 2 burn complaints, 1 remote alarm, 1 medical and 1 investigation.
- Stations 1 and 2 participated in the Community Clean-Up in Lansdowne and Seeley's Bay.
- The Annual General Meeting was held at Station 1 on April 29. 73 members were in attendance; this was the largest member turnout for a general meeting.

Fire Services

- The Ontario Fire Chiefs Association Conference and Trade Show is being held in Toronto from May 1 - 4. Chief Prior, DC Latimer, and FPO Richardson, along with other officers and firefighters are attending.
- The training schedule has been completed for July December 2024.
- The annual SCBA Flow Testing is scheduled for June 19 and 20.

Regional Training Center

- The final training day for off-site delivery of Firefighter II to Augusta, FOY, and Prescott will be held on May 4th. However, the exam that was originally scheduled for May 5th had to be postponed by Academic Standard and Evaluation due to a shortage of proctors. A new date for the exam is yet to be determined.
- Course preparation work is being completed for the upcoming commercial cooking and NFPA 1041 Instructor I courses for OFC instructors.
