- Special Event Permits

Fire Services

Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 5 incidents. 2 remote alarms, 1 medical, 1 burn complaint, 1 vehicle fire, which was stood down as the call was in the Kingston zone.
- The recent conference for Fire Chiefs had a primary focus on mental health, PTSD, and firefighter cancers. Firefighters have a 40% higher risk of developing occupational cancers compared to the general population. The Ontario Budget for 2024 has recently declared that an investment of \$30 million will be made over the next three years to help furnish the Ontario Fire Services with adequate personal protective equipment (PPE). In addition, specialized decontamination tools will also be provided to clean and sanitize firefighter gear, mitigating the long-term effects of exposure to chemicals and other fire-related contaminants.

Fire Services

 Another main topic discussed was the implementation of a new technology that will allow for simultaneous notification province-wide. This new system will enable municipalities, such as Leeds 1000 Islands, to coordinate dispatching between Paramedic Services and Fire Services. This will streamline notifications, facilitate faster response times, drive better patient outcomes, and enhance the province's overall response model.

Regional Training Center

- Several exams have been scheduled with AS&E for June 9.
- Stinson Fuels attended the RTC to do a spring service on the system for 2024.
- All Adjunct Instructors (Al's) from across the province met online with the Fire College on Wednesday, May 8, to discuss changes to curriculum, guidebooks, and pay rate. We currently have 5 Ontario Fire College Adjunct Instructors internally who are not only involved in our own training center but also train firefighters at other RTCs across the province.
