Potential Trail development
Along Lower Mill Pond to Jonas Street.

Future Public Washroom facility

Shaded Rest Area with views

Existing Wellhead
for potable drinking water

Establish Paved Shoulder on Lyndhurst Road – North side
- Create safe pedestrian corridor to Canada Post office, etc.

Potential Parking Lot
- 10/12 vehicles.

Construction of a new Community Band-Shell
- Musical events, community gathering point, concerts, etc.

National Historic Site Monument

Initiate Potential negotiations to purchase the old
Heritage Carriage Building – Possible Visitors Centre.

Tertiary Bridge Crossing – Lower Mill Pond
- Connect to Ormond Street as part of Trails development.

Embankment / Wall requires
In-depth restoration.

National Historic Site Interpretive Pavilion

Bicycle / Pedestrian Trail to Kendrick's Park / Beach.

Ford Street Portage
- Improved access to Docks & Launching
for kayaks and canoes.

New Secondary Wrought Iron Bridge Crossing
- Pedestrian, Wheelchair, Walker, Stroller, Bicycle;
- Constructed with Wrought Iron to compliment the Heritage Bridge;
- Designed to stay faithful to the original lines / arches of the stone bridge.
- Provides safe connection/passage from the village over the Lyndhurst waterway;
- Direct route from existing sidewalks to new proposed paved shoulder corridor.

Consider reinstating WWI red granite obelisk
To original position at Furnace Falls Park.

Potential for Future Development opportunities
- Multi-purpose Community Building; Parking solutions; Retail business.

New Limestone screening Pathway
- From Lyndhurst Road to Washroom facilities &
Connecting to Waterfront Trail via parking area.

**Complete Renovations to the existing F.F. Park
Seasonal Washroom Facilities** – Upgrades, AODA
Barrier-free accessibility, new pump house, etc.

Potential modifications to the Library Building
- Establish Year-round Public Washroom facilities.

New large boulders for
Resting / sitting in Park.

Additional Kayak/Canoe/Small Craft Mooring
- With shoreline Fish Cleaning Station.

**Additional Way-Finding Infrastructure needed throughout –
- Signage, Displays, Interpretive Stations –**
Should have thematic continuity and integrated storytelling.
• FABR and Heritage corridors;
• National Historic Site;
• GRWA and local Provincially Significant Wetlands.
