

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEEDS AND THE THOUSAND ISLANDS

BY-LAW NO. 14-01

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE DATE ON WHICH A REDUCED LOAD PERIOD SHALL START OR END ON HIGHWAYS UNDER JURISDICTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEEDS AND THE THOUSAND ISLANDS.

WHEREAS subsection 7 of Section 122 of The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 as amended, provides that a municipality may, by by-law, designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS a reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands;


AND THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of subsection 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act apply to all highways under the jurisdiction of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands during the period from the 15th day of February to the 15th day of May, inclusive, in each and every year.
2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
3. The Public Works Superintendent and the Roads Committee Chairperson shall be empowered to make adjustments to the period of reduced load comprehensively or per individual road based on immediate road conditions.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 12TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2001.
