Public Meetings

- Four public meetings have been scheduled for 6 p.m. on Monday, May 5, prior to the Council meeting.
 - 911 Country Lane- Rezoning to satisfy a condition of consent to recognize reduced lot area and frontage for the retained lands.
 - 61 Shipman's Lane- Rezoning of the water lot to a Tourist Commercial Exception
 Zone to add a stationary dock
 - 91 Shipman's Lane- Rezoning to allow the expansion of an existing detached garage and to include a sleeping cabin as a permitted use.
 - 934 Burma Lane- Rezoning to satisfy a condition of consent approval for a lot addition to rezone the area of the lot addition to Tourist Commercial and allow the construction of a septic system to support the existing tourist lodging establishment at 931 Burma Lane.
