## **Fire Services**

#### Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 23 emergency incidents this past week: 6 fire alarm activations, including 2 on islands, requiring marine units, 3 medical assistance calls, with 1 requiring a marine unit, 5 calls following a brief storm with wires down and arcing, 3 calls for Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms for structures with higher levels of CO in them due to back up generator exhaust being drawn inside the homes. Fire Services reminds all residents to know the dangers of CO when using generators during power outages. 1 public assistance call, 1 fire on an island, 1 vehicle fire for an RV motor home and 3 at one location following the high wind event.
- Six members of the Fire Service attended the Howe Island Fire Department for Licensing for Marine Units.
