# **Fire Services**

Fire Administration

- Fire services had a very busy week, responding to 42 calls for service. The ice storm created 26 calls for wires down or wires arcing, 5 well-being checks, 2 transformer fires, 1 reported generator explosion, 4 activated fire alarms, 1 chimney fire, 1 carbon monoxide call, 1 medical assistance call, and the first grass fire of the season.
- Thank you to all station Officers and Firefighters for their continued work and dedication to Leeds Fire. On average, for Sunday's storm, fire services responded to 2 to 3 calls at once for most of the day. As this was happening, the Officers in charge of the calls relayed messages for coverage to ensure that all areas of the Township were adequately covered.
- Tuesday as a precaution fire service attended the areas still without power to check on the well-being of the affected residents.
- New gloves and boots for the recruit class have arrived and will be issued for their live fire weekend coming up this weekend.
