Fire Services

Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 30 emergency incidents over the past two weeks, it is an extremely busy time for the fire service: 3 brush fires (2 island), 1 structure fire, 1 internal sight of smoke, 5 medical calls (2 island), 4 motor vehicle collisions, 2 public hazards, 3 activated alarms for fire or carbon monoxide, 3 water rescues on the river and 8 burn complaints.
- Fire services would like to remind residents when they see flashing red lights and/or green lights to please slow down and move to the right to allow the first responders to get to the emergency safely.

Fire Prevention

- Full burn ban placed for all TLTI residents and properties. This means no open-air burning within the township, including campfires and fireworks.
- County wide burn ban placed for all municipalities in Leeds and Grenville
