Fire Services

Fire Administration

- Fire Services ended the year 2025 with a total of 483 calls for service. This is 106 calls ahead of 2024.
- Fire services responded to 6 emergency incidents this first week of January: 2 fire alarm activations, 3 motor vehicle accidents, and 1 carbon monoxide alarm.
- The office of the Ontario Fire Marshal has announced its funding allotment to the Leeds Fire Service. Through the Fire Protection Grant, Leeds Fire was granted approximately \$65,000 to support Cancer Prevention. The service is looking to use these funds for washer/extractors and dryers for all stations. The addition of these units will help to prevent the transmission of carcinogens in firefighting gear.

Planning and Development

- Winter Parking

- To allow snowplows to safely clear roads, no person shall park a motor vehicle on any of the streets, sidewalks, or highways within the Corporation between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time between the 1st day of December and the 31st day of March inclusive in the year next following
- The Parking By-law, 23-064, is enforced through Administrative Monetary Penalties, By-law 22-044. The penalty for parking on a Township Road during winter parking restrictions may range from \$40.00 to having the vehicle towed at the owners expense.
- If your vehicle has been towed, the license plate number, date and towing company information will be provided to the OPP and the Township administration office.
