Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 8 emergency incidents this week: 4 calls for medical assistance (2 island calls), 2 motor vehicle accidents, 1 smell of smoke in a commercial occupancy, 1 Public Assistance call, and 1 burn complaint on an island.
- Officers met at Station 1 for officer training. This is a new program which is being run to enhance officer development.

Fire Prevention:

- The Burn ban is still in effect; the only allowable burning is for campfires. Weather conditions are being monitored daily, conditions remain very dry throughout the Township.
- Firefighters held the final scheduled "Dock to Door" program and demonstration this past Saturday. Fire Services remain available to meet with residents who have questions or concerns regarding island safety and fire pumps.

Regional Training Centre

 Preparations for the remaining 2025 classes, including NFPA 1033 Investigator and NFPA 100101 Recruit Firefighter, which includes internal candidates, Augusta Fire, Merrickville Fire and Athens Fire, are underway.
