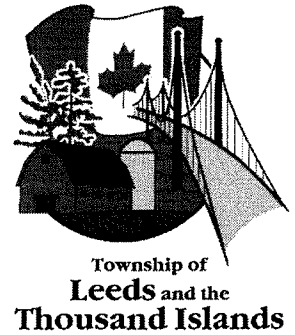

Declaration of Qualifications – Council

Municipal Elections Act, 1996

Declaration of Qualifications

For the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands

Councillor – Ward 1 Vacancy

!, ANDREW LOGAN, a candidate for the office of Councillor, Ward 1,

Do solemnly Declare that:

1. I am qualified pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* and the *Municipal Act, 2001* to hold the office of Councillor, Ward 3.
2. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 1, I am at least eighteen years of age, a Canadian citizen, a resident of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands or the owner or tenant of land in the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands or the spouse of such owner or tenant.
3. I am not ineligible or disqualified under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act, 1990* or any other Act to hold the above-mentioned office.
4. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 3,
 - I am not an employee of the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands or local board, or if I am an employee of the Corporation of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands, I am on a unpaid leave of absence as provided for by section 30 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.
 - I am not a judge of any court.
 - I am not a member of the Assembly as provided in the *Legislative Assembly Act, 1990* or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada or, if I am such as person, I will provide proof of my resignation in a form satisfactory to the Clerk of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands prior to 2:00 on the last day for applications, February 5th, 2025. I understand that the Clerk of the Township of Leeds and the Thousand

Islands will reject my application for the above-mentioned office if I fail to provide proof of resignation by this deadline.

- I am not a Crown employee within the meaning of the *Public Service of Ontario Act*, 1990 or if I am a Crown employee, I have followed and will continue to follow all the relevant provisions of Part III of such *Act*.
5. I am not prohibited from voting at the municipal election under subsection 17(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996.
 6. Without limiting the generality of paragraph 1,
 - I am not a person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a penal or correctional institution.
 - I am not a person who was convicted of a corrupt practice described in subsection 90(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, during an election that occurred less than five years prior to October 24, 2022.
 7. I am not a candidate who was convicted of a corrupt practice under the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996 or of an offence under the Criminal Code (Canada), in connection with an act or omission with respect to a municipal election if the Voting Day in that election is less than six years prior to October 24, 2022.
 8. I am not disqualified from holding office by reason of any violations of the election campaign financial requirements or violations for not filing the financial statement pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996.



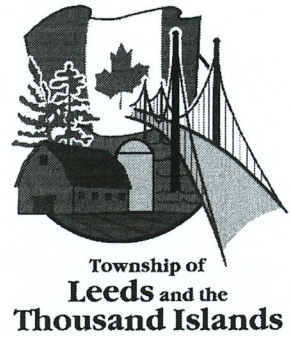

PERSONAL STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

Andrew Logan

I am submitting my application for appointment to Council for the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands based on my commitment to public service, a deep appreciation for this community and its residents, and a professional background in public policy, regulatory oversight, and work within complex regulatory environments.

Over the past decade, I have worked within the Ontario Public Service, the Legislative Assembly, and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario in roles focused on legislative support, policy development, and regulatory decision-making. At Queen's Park, I supported the advancement of legislation through research and policy analysis within a structured, high-accountability environment. At the AGCO, I worked within a regulatory framework requiring careful interpretation of legislation, risk assessment, and ensuring decisions were practical and defensible in application.

These roles developed my ability to work through complex issues, balance competing priorities, and decision-making grounded in evidence, process, and accountability.

I work in a client-facing financial services role supporting community members in making informed financial decisions. This work reinforces the importance of trust, clear communication, and accountability, and has provided direct perspective on how financial and policy decisions affect households in practical terms.

I hold a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science with a minor in Sociology from the University of Windsor, along with professional development and certification in communications, leadership, compliance, accessibility, and inclusivity.

The Township is currently navigating a period of growth and transition, where infrastructure capacity, housing availability, and service delivery are becoming increasingly vital considerations. As a rural and waterfront municipality with a large geographic area and rural communities, we face ongoing challenges related to maintaining roads and bridges, supporting island and remote residents, and managing higher costs associated with dispersed service delivery. There is a need to balance growth with the preservation of our Township's rural character and natural environment, while also addressing longer-term pressures such as an aging population, workforce retention, and the need for sustained economic activity beyond seasonal tourism.

If appointed, I would bring a steady, collaborative, and evidence-based approach to Council, with a focus on transparency, accountability, and clear communication with residents. I believe decisions should be understandable in both process and rationale, particularly in a community where erosion of trust in local governance is essential.
