### Fire Administration

- Fire services responded to 15 emergency incidents: 2 medical calls, 2 fire alarm activations, 2 public assistance calls, 1 motor vehicle accident, 4 hydro-related calls, 1 tree down, 1 car fire, 1 railway tie on fire and 1 CO alarm.
- With unpredictable weather, it's important to have supplies for prolonged power outages. Ensure backup power for basements and have your generator inspected. Never run generators indoors, and keep windows closed when the generator is running. Carbon monoxide alarms are required on every level of your home.
