Fire Services

Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 7 emergency incidents: 6 motor vehicle accidents and 1 fire alarm activation.
- Fire hydrants in the Village of Lansdowne were cleared by firefighters
- All stations are participating in Ice Water training this week, which includes awareness and theory, followed by practical skills in the St. Lawrence River.

Fire Prevention

- Prevention staff attended the East Region Chapter meeting of the Ontario Municipal Fire Prevention Officers Association. As part of the meeting, each participating department received three cases of smoke alarms, donated through a joint partnership between the Fire Marshal's Public Fire Safety Council and Kiddie. These alarms will be distributed within the communities we serve to support ongoing fire safety and prevention efforts.

What is a Significant Weather Event, and why would TLTI declare one?

- A Significant Weather Event is declared when severe or unusual weather conditions create hazardous road conditions and make it difficult for municipal crews to meet standard maintenance times. Examples include, heavy snowfall, freezing rain, ice storms, flooding, or extreme wind.
- When an event is declared it allows the municipality to focus first on restoring safety and mobility across the entire road network. Crews continue working, but conditions may mean it takes longer than usual to clear and treat roads.
