Fire Services

Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 6 emergency incidents this week: 2 burn complaints, 2 medical assistance calls, a possible structure fire, and a water rescue.
- The Fire Chief met with the Office of the Fire Marshal (OFM) regarding the new \$20 million grant for Ontario Fire Services to assist with cancer prevention.

Fire Prevention:

- Met with the OFM advisor regarding multiple fire department orders for compliance.
- Two commercial inspections were conducted.
- The Fire Ban dropped to the lowest level, but with caution. Fire Services will monitor the weather and dry conditions.
